

2015 Corporate Cup Team Information

The goal of the Corporate Cup is to bring together companies, their employees, and families in a community setting to promote friendly competition while also promoting health, wellness, and being active.

PURPOSE

- To promote a lifetime awareness and commitment to physical activity.
- To foster pride in the community and in companies for which we work.
- To create positive relationships with members of our community and fellow businesses.

ELIGIBILITY AND DIVISIONS

Any area businesses or organizations are eligible to participate in the Corporate Cup.

All participants must be company employees, retirees, or serve on the Board of Directors or be a spouse of the employee. All employees must be on the payroll at a part-time or full-time basis. Regularly scheduled contractors who receive a 1099 are eligible to participate, along with their spouses.

Anyone competing or participating in an event must sign the Corporate Cup Waiver and submit it with the team roster.

Individuals not employed by a corporation, company or agency may enter the competition, provided they form teams as representatives of their professional or community group(s). Examples are as follows: Rotary, Lion's Club, Kiwanis, churches, Marietta Main Street, etc...

The Corporate Cup Committee reserves the right to review all team entries relative to eligibility.

EVENTS

MMH Wayne Street Campus:

- 5K Run
- 1.5 Mile Walk

Washington County Career Center:

- Cornhole
- Tug-of-War
- Golf Putting Contest
- Hot Shot Soccer
- Basketball Hot Shot
- Football – Punt, Pass, & Kick Contests
- Obstacle Course

FEES

Cost per team:

1 – 10 participants	\$200
11 – 25 participants	\$400

Businesses may register more than one team. Additional teams will receive 10% off of team fee.

Individuals may participate in multiple events.

DEADLINE

All teams must have entry forms, team rosters, t-shirt order form, waivers and fees turned into the Marietta Family YMCA by September 30th.

VOLUNTEERS

It takes many volunteers for the Corporate Cup to run smoothly. If anyone in your company is willing to volunteer, please fill out the volunteer sheet included in the registration packet. Companies will be awarded 5 points per volunteer per event. Employees participating in events may volunteer for other events only providing they are not participating in that event. Points will not be awarded for employees helping out their team during an event (such as rebounding for basketball, etc.). There is a volunteer sponsorship opportunity (see sponsorship form). Volunteer sponsorships will also receive 5 points per volunteer.

ROSTERS

Up to 25 people per team.

Companies are permitted to enter more than one team.

A person cannot be on more than one roster, even if their company has more than one team.

Once submitted, rosters may not change unless written request is submitted and approved by the Corporate Cup Committee.

SCORING

Scoring for each event:

1 st place	50 team points
2 nd place	45 team points
3 rd place	40 team points
4 th place	35 team points
5 th place	30 team points
6 th place	25 team points
7 th place	20 team points
8 th place	15 team points
9 th place	10 team points
10 th place	5 team points

5K, 1.5 mile walk and golf putting contest will award points 1st – 10th place for both men's and women's divisions.

Cornhole, tug-of-war, hot shot soccer, basketball, football, and obstacle course will only award one set of points for 1st – 10th place.

We will use "CROSS COUNTRY SCORING" for the 5K, 1.5M Walk, Basketball, and Golf Putting events. Cornhole, Tug-of-War, Soccer, Football, and Obstacle Course will award to the 1st, 2nd, 3rd place team.

CEO, Executive Director or President Participation is awarded an additional 100 points if the CEO, Executive Director, or President participates in Corporate Cup. The CEO, Executive Director, or President can participate in multiple events but will only receive a total of 100 points.

Participants will be awarded 5 points per event for participation. Participants must complete event to receive the participation points.

AWARDS

The overall company winner with the most points combined will receive the Corporate Cup travelling trophy for one year.

A plaque will be presented to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners in each event.

A team "Spirit Award" will be given to the team chosen by the Corporate Cup planning committee who demonstrates outstanding spirit and overall enthusiasm.

Travelling trophies will be passed on the following year to the new "winners."

There will be an award ceremony after the final event is completed. Each participant will receive a food coupon for snacks and a drink after the event. Additional food will be available for purchase.

T-SHIRTS

T-shirts will be provided to each participant. Companies will chose a team color for t-shirts at the time of registration.

GAME SCHEDULE

Subject to change based on the number of teams participating and inclement weather. Double elimination may be changed to single elimination tournament if number of teams is too many to complete in allotted timeframe. Participants can call our Marietta Family YMCA for updated details on event schedules due to weather at (740) 373-2250

Teams who do not show for scheduled time of event will receive a 50-point reduction in overall score.

HEALTH SCREENINGS

Marietta Memorial Health System will offer FREE health screenings for Body Mass Index and Blood Pressure during the events at the Washington County Career Center

RULE VIOLATIONS

Teams or team members found in violation of event rules will be penalized in the event in which the infraction was noted. Teams finishing behind the penalized team will be moved up in the point standings accordingly.

The Corporate Cup Committee reserves the right to review all rule violations.

PROTESTS

A protest during the game must be made immediately after the call in question. A judgment call cannot be protested. Protests will not be accepted after the game is complete.

DISQUALIFICATIONS

- Alcoholic Beverages not permitted
- Abusive language or conduct
- Fights
- Cheating
- Profanity

May result in team disqualification from event and Committee will review if any further action will be necessary.
